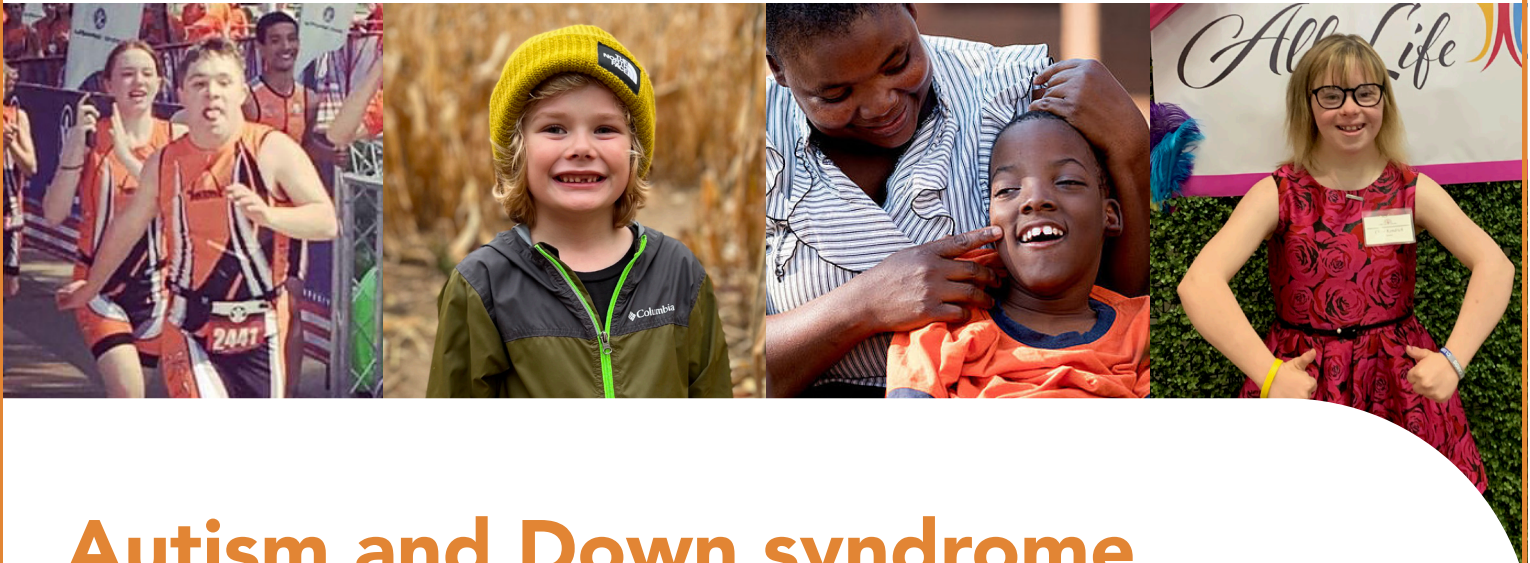


To commemorate the 18<sup>th</sup> anniversary of World Down Syndrome Day – WDSO 2023
