In recent years, thousands of children in America and around the world have undergone sex-rejecting procedures such as puberty-suppressing hormones, cross-sex hormones, and surgical procedures. These types of procedures are mostly based on the so-called “Dutch Protocol,” endorsed by the World Professional Association for Transgender Health (WPATH) and the Endocrine Society (ES).

This event will be an opportunity to hear from HHS officials, advocates for children’s and parental rights, and people who have first-hand experience of children being drawn into gender transition, social debates surrounding parental authority in such cases, and abuses by medical professionals and institutions, and the attempts to silence any debate or scientific inquiry on the issues.
